ISSUE: Ratify Appointment to the Urban Renewal Advisory Committee

**BACKGROUND:**

On March 5, 2013, the Council authorized the formation and composition of an Urban Renewal Advisory Committee. The role of the committee is to serve in an advisory capacity to the Urban Renewal Agency. The scope of responsibilities includes, but are not limited to, review of the annual proposed budget, review and recommendations on current and future projects, and long range planning, reviewing proposed plan amendments, and other matters as required by the Agency.

The membership consists of one member of the Planning Commission, one member of the Coos Bay Downtown Association, one member of the Community Coalition of Empire, one member of the Eastside Neighborhood Committee, and three citizen-at-large positions. On June 30, 2015 the Council ratified the appointment of Julie Graham to replace a former member of the committee who had resigned. Recently, the City was notified by the President of the Community Coalition of Empire of their desire to appoint Joanne Moss as their representative instead of Julie Graham. It should be noted that Joanne Moss attended and represented the Community Coalition of Empire at the past joint URA / UR Advisory Committee work session last month.
