ISSUE: Award of Contract to Resurface Coos River Highway

BACKGROUND:

A portion of Coos River Highway was damaged during an intense storm event in December 6, 2015. After an extensive review of existing conditions, ODOT and City that Coos River Highway required embankment stabilization before the road rehabilitation could be performed. Thus council approved a contract with GeoStabilization International to stabilize the embankment. I'm pleased to report that embankment stabilization is now completed, and the City has completed the bidding process for the road resurfacing. Bids were received from Benny Hempstead Construction and Johnson Rock Products (See bid tab below). Scope of work involves 200 LF of road rehabilitation, guardrail installation, and 12th Street pothole repair

If it pleases council, approve Benny Hempstead Excavation bid in the amount of \$49,750.00 with a 10% contingency not to exceed \$55,000.00.
