ISSUE: Award Contract to Replace Sewer Line and Resurface West Park Road

BACKGROUND:

West Park Road failed because of the storm event this past winter in December 2015. The West Park Road rehabilitation project has been identified through FEMA for a reimbursement project. The City advertised the West Park Road Rehabilitation project and received four bids (see table below). The scope of the project involves replacing 100 ft. of sewer main, a storm water catch basin, roadbed rebuild, paving, striping, and guard rail install. Benny Hempstead Excavation is the low bidder.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:

The cost for this work is expected to be reimbursed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

ACTION REQUESTED:

If it pleases Council, award the contract to Benny Hempstead Excavation for the West Park Road rehabilitation project in the amount of \$88,980.00 with a \$5,000 (5.6%) contingency so the total project cost is not to exceed \$93,980.00.
