ISSUE: **OLCC New Outlet Off-Premises Sale License Application – Coos Head Food Co-Op**

BACKGROUND:

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 471.166 establishes the process for local governments to make recommendations to OLCC regarding approval of or denial of initial OLCC license applications and any additional privileges to their existing OLCC license. As part of the process, the Police Department reviews all initial and additional privilege applications to ensure compliance with applicable regulations. The City Council is charged with the responsibility for recommending approval or denial of these applications to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission bases on information submitted by the Police Department.

On June 22, 2016, the City received an application from members of the Coos Head Food Co-Op applying for an OLCC Off-Premises sales license that would allow the sale of beverages that contain alcohol to be consumed off-premises at the proposed business located at 353 South 2nd Street in Coos Bay.

Records Supervisor Christine Esperance has conducted a records check of the proposed location of the business, and the proposed OLCC applicants. The investigation revealed nothing that would prevent the applicants from obtaining the OLCC Off-Premises Sales License.

ADVANTAGES:

A business, operating in compliance with OLCC regulations, can add to the economic stability of our community.

RECOMMENDATION:

If it pleases the Council, staff recommends the approval of the Off-Premises OLCC Sales License to the Coos Head Food Co-Op located at 353 South 2nd Street, Coos Bay Oregon.
